Macintoshes, released October 1989 Full-featured AutoCAD Crack Mac for Macintosh was released in October 1989. The first retail version was called AcDWizards, and the second retail version was AcGale. Only the first retail version of the app had a native-look interface, with the second retail version implementing a faux native-look interface on top of the Mac OS. The first retail version of the app was priced at US\$ 1,995 and it was the first product developed in-house by a software company.

Microsoft Windows, released November 1990 AutoCAD for Windows was released in November 1990. The initial version was similar to the Macintosh version, but was not directly connected to Apple's Macintosh. Windows and Macintosh versions of AutoCAD were compatible up to release 6.0 for Windows, and up to release 6.3 for Macintosh. Windows and Macintosh versions of AutoCAD were also compatible from version 7.0 onwards. In 1989, AutoCAD had been rebranded as AutoCAD LT. LT stands for "light" and is a registered trademark of Autodesk, Inc. 1990s In the late 1990s and early 2000s, the World Wide Web became popular as a new medium for sharing information. Adobe Flash, released in 1994, enabled users to create and view multimedia files. This spawned the growth of the web app in software development. Web apps could be released and updated much faster and cheaper than traditional software applications. Standalone Web App, released March 2001 Autodesk released the first version of AutoCAD Web App in March 2001. The app did not have an external executable (application) that could be distributed with it, and was built on Adobe Flex, a web app technology that could be embedded into web pages. Web App with External Executable, released April 2007 In 2007, Autodesk released AutoCAD LT Web App with an external executable, also called ADLW. The executable is an archive that users can download and install. The installer creates a shortcut on the users' desktop that launches the web app. Web app installations did not require an Internet connection. Python In 2004, Python language was integrated into AutoCAD Cracked 2022 Latest Version. This release included Python scripting tools that allow the creation of graphical user interfaces, external Python modules that can be used in AutoCAD Cracked 2022 Latest Version, and extensions to the Autodesk interchange file format. AutoCAD developers can also create Python scripts to perform functions that can easily be used in AutoCAD, similar to how one would write a VBA or Visual LISP macro in a workbook. AutoCAD includes Python for Linux and Windows and the Python development tools (such as IDLE, Python for Windows, Python for Windows Desktop, and Python 3 for Windows) are available for download.
